REGISTRATION FOR GAMES

- takes place on Wednesday 31st January from 9:00 to 15:00;
- register at the Clarion Hotel (participants not using the Emil Open accommodation register on 1.1. (9:30-10:00 in the call room at the Lipno Ski Resort);
- the accommodation coordinator will give you all the essential information and the participation package for the whole team;
- during the registration we do not accept any changes in your team (number of persons, substitution of one person for another, change of sport), so your team must come to the games with the composition entered in the system!
- if you have not sent scanned and signed liability consents, personal data processing consents
 and safety affidavits for your entire team (including assistants), it is requested that you
 provide these documents at registration! Without these documents, you will not be able to
 participate in the Games!

TRANSPORT

EMIL OPEN - ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Transportation to the games is individual. If you arrive by car or private bus/microbus, parking is available directly at the Clarion Hotel.

The need for transport from the train station to the Clarion Hotel and back was discussed individually with the transport coordinator.

TRANSPORT DURING THE GAMES

A bus is provided to transfer to the Lipno Ski Resort. In case you come by minibus, bus or you want to use your own car, it is possible.

You have reported the use of organised transport between the Clarion Hotel and the Lipno Ski Resort to the transport coordinator - **if you have not done so, your individual transport will be taken into account**. The destination address at the Lipno Ski Resort is:

ACCOMMODATION

SUMMARY/IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Each participant will be given an accreditation card upon registration for the games, which will take place at the hotel upon arrival.
- You must carry your accreditation card with you at all times during the Games and identify yourself with it at the hotel, sports venue and food service. At the same time you will use it during the accompanying programme.
- If you have not sent scanned and signed liability consents, personal data processing consents and safety affidavits for your entire team (including accompanying persons), it is requested that you provide these documents upon registration
- Each delegation must send a representative to the technical meeting on 31st January at approx. 17:00 (more in the Sports section) to take over all necessary information. If you are the only accompanying person, the athlete/s may accompany you.
- Breakfast and dinner are served at the Clarion Hotel, see accommodation and meals.
- Lunch snacks are served on 1st and 2nd February at the sports venue (Ski Resort Lipno) and 3rd February at accompanying programme.
- For the safe conduct of the games, the following must be observed:
 - o the rules of this manual,
 - o traffic regulations of the Czech Republic,
 - o the rules of conduct at sports grounds and other venues.
- Liability the organizer is not liable for injuries to athletes, their escorts or for accidents, illnesses, loss of objects and damage to them. Each delegation will send a signed "Declaration of Responsibility" to the organizer by the check-in deadline by email and will hand it in at the Games registration if this deadline is not met. Without it, participation in the Games is not possible!
- A paramedic will be available at each venue during the Games.
- Insurance is to be taken out by each delegation separately.
- It is no longer possible to send substitutes for the athletes!

SPORT SIDE OF THE GAMES GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Language Czech, English
- **2. Target group** youth with a physical, intellectual, visual or hearing impairment from 10 to 26 years old (competitors must be of age for at least 1 day this year or receive an exemption).
- **3.** Adaptive sports Section 1 Para alpine skiing and snowboarding, Section 2 cross-country skiing, snowshoes.
- 4. Categories:

OPEN

- supports and motivates beginners
- is open to everybody sport beginners (or advanced athletes) regardless of whether or not they are registered in a sport club or a national or international federation. They must, however, have some training experience in any kind of sport competitions
- by submitting the entry, you acknowledge that:
 - a competitor is medically fit for the performance of sporting activities in a given sport,
 - a competitor has training experience and skills in the sport (para alpine skiing, cross-country skiing or snow-boarding)
- assessment the principle of relativity will be used. It is based on the assessment of current performance in relation to the individual participant, which allows to achieve adequate assessment in each category. The assessment criterion is approaching, achieving or surpassing one's own results from qualifications in the finals. Each participant who completed the qualifying race advances to the finals. More details will be specified at the technical meeting of the sport before the competitions.
- **awards** all finals participants will be announced and awarded at the medal ceremony, the first three will be awarded medals.
- **5.** Every athlete is allowed to complete in **one adaptive sport only**.
- **6.** Each athlete participates in the **demonstration sports** based on his/her own decision and time availability.
- 7. Athletes and their staff are required to get familiar with the sport rules and to comply with them, including their adherence to the timetable, the arrivals at sport venues etc.
- **8. Transportation** from the accommodation to the sports ground is provided by the organizer on the basis of demand. Participants who have not responded in time to the transport coordinator's instructions are transported by their own vehicle.
- 9. Obligatory attendance at the coach and staff technical meeting 31 January, 5 pm 6 pm where delegation's representatives will be provided will all necessary instructions in the particular sport. Every delegation should send as many representatives as is the number of sports they are participating in. The meeting place will be specified.
- **10.** For organisational and safety reasons, **only registered athletes** and their staff (including assistance dogs) **have access to the sport venues**.
- 11. Athletes are obliged to compete with their own sports equipment (adjusted and modified downhill and cross-country skis/monolines, etc.) or compensatory aids and





protective equipment (helmet, goggles, gloves) suitable for safe competition. The affidavit will be handed in by the coaches/responsible person at the initial technical meeting.

- **12.** The **timetable for each competition** will be announced (email, web, Facebook) always the evening before the competition day at the latest.
- **13.** the **term PARA** conveys a derivation of the word parallel for all participants, not paraplegic disability

PARA ALPINE SKIING

Name: Para alpine skiing

Date: 01. – 02. February. 2024; 10:00 - 14:00

Place: Ski areál Lipno, 382 78 Lipno nad Vltavou, www.lipno.info

Venue:

- Ski area Lipno, ski slope Snowcross (500 m long, 15 50 m width, 54 m elevation).
- Cableway Lipenská (double seat, 400 m long, travel time 3 minutes, capacity 1 200 p/h).
- Parking P2, next to the slope
- The racing slope will be the same for all types of downhill:
 - 1. standing (mental d., visual im., hearing im., physical im. walking)
 - 2. sitting (physical im. monoski users)
 - 3. sitting with assistant

Disciplines:

- 1) day qualifications
- 2) day modified slalom

Competition system: training, qualifications and final attempts will depends on snow

conditions. Clarification at the latest at the meeting of the leaders.

Assessment: OPEN category - see General information

Rules: The competitions follow the FIS rules with the additions defined here

for the OPEN format and the relativity rule with modifications

designed for disabled sports.

Note to coaches/accompanying persons: athlete presentations will be made each morning at the venue. Coaches are responsible for getting the athlete to the presentation on time (after warm-up) and in the convocation room (CALL ROOM - located at the lower lift station) according to the start time. Registration will take place before the start of the race, more at the technical meeting. Coaches must stay only in the designated areas, further clarification at the initial technical meeting.





Competitors must show proof of properly adjusted skis, snowboard, etc. otherwise they will not be allowed on the slope. Proof of an affidavit from the coach/accompanying persons at the initial technical meeting.

The organiser reserves the right to change or modify the regulations and rules of downhill skiing and snowboarding if required to maintain fair play and snow or international hygiene conditions of the situation.

CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

Sport director: Jakub Válek

Name: Cross-country skiing

Date: 1. – 2. 2. 2024; 10:00 - 14:00

Place: Ski area Lipno, 382 78 Lipno nad Vltavou, www.lipno.info

Venue: A short cross-country skiing circuit of about 300m. Each competitor can now use

the option of a pair of distances - short and long, based on the distance entered in the application form. There will be a new option to set up a relay on Friday,

running 4x300m.

Category OPEN:

- standing (mental d., visual im., hearing im., physical im. walking)

- sitting (wheelchair users etc.

Disciplines:

- short runs 900m + 1500m
- long runs 1500m + 3000m
- 4x300m relay (Friday, Mixed)

The competition system will be based on snow conditions and the time required for training on the track. A competitor in the **OPEN** category can enter two of the announced disciplines – short track (900m + 1500m) long track (1500m + 3000m). Qualifying competitions will take place on 1st February from 10:00 to 14:00.

MIXED category - only for 4x 300m relay. I.e. minimum 2 and maximum 3 athletes from the OPEN category + minimum 1 and maximum 2 registered intact escort or volunteer from the organizers. There is no need to observe club or nationality affiliation, both genders and all types of handicaps compete together.

Assessment: OPEN category - according to the principle of relativity. All qualify for the final round, based on the actual performance achieved with maximum effort in the qualification.

Rules: Competing according to the current rules. Start command by whistle, flag. Depending on snow conditions, interval starts will be in 15-30 sec, individually.

Note to coaches/accompanying persons: athletes will be presented each morning at the venue. Coaches are responsible for getting athletes to the presentation on time (after warm-up) and in the





convocation room (CALL ROOM) according to the start time. Check in at the start no earlier than 15 min. and no later than 10 min. before the actual start time. Coaches must stay only in the designated areas, further clarification at the initial technical meeting.

The competitor must show properly prepared cross-country skis, otherwise he/she will not be allowed to start. Proof of an affidavit from the coach/chaperone at the initial technical meeting.

The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the regulations and rules of cross-country skiing if required to maintain fair play and snow or hygiene conditions of a given situation.

SNOWSHOES

Date: 1. - 2. 2. 2024

Snowshoe training demonstrations and competition will be conducted in the cross-country skiing area. The program will be in MIX format. **Good winter footwear is required.**
