TRAIL THROUGH THE TREETOPS LIPNO

The Lipno Treetop Trail, a unique national trail and the first of its kind in the Czech Republic, welcomed its first visitors on 10 July 2012. The trail is sensitively integrated into the landscape around Lake Lipno and is a unique addition to Lipno. It completes the offer of sports, educational and entertainment activities.

The trail includes educational didactic elements that will enrich and broaden the knowledge of nature, its protection and the function of the forest. Three adventure stations with rope elements are designed not only for young visitors, but also for those who are still young and have not lost their taste for adventure. They are located at a height of 24 metres.

CASTLE HLUBOKÁ + ZOO

Hluboká nad Vltavou Castle is considered one of the most romantic castles in the Czech Republic. Inspired by the English Windsor Castle, it offers 140 richly decorated rooms and 11 towers. It boasts a unique collection of tapestries and a large English park. The castle was a favourite residence of the noble Schwarzenberg family and still attracts visitors today with its fairytale atmosphere.

Visitors to the zoo are attracted by modern exhibitions such as the aviary pavilion with water birds or the brown bear enclosure. The zoo offers interactive programmes, playgrounds and educational activities, so that all generations can enjoy their visit.

TOUR OF THE TOWN HALL

ČESKÉ BUDĚJOVICE

The Renaissance one-storey corner building covered with four gable roofs is located on Svornost' Square. The nave is vaulted with a cross vault.

The interior of the building is accessed by a broken Gothic portal, above which is a sign with the emblem of the five-leaved Rose of Rosenberg. On the first floor there is a hall with a modern beamed ceiling on brackets. In the right part of the vestibule there is a ceramic map of Český Krumlov on the wall. The medieval cellars under most of the building are vaulted mostly with stone.
