REGISTRATION FOR THE GAMES

- Registration takes place on Tuesday, January 21 (all day) and Wednesday, January 22 (until 3:00 PM);
- Register at Hotel Clarion (participants not using Emil Open accommodation register on January 22 between 9:30–10:00 AM in the call room at Ski Resort Lipno)
- The accommodation coordinator will provide all essential information for your team
- **No team changes** (number of participants, replacements, or sports changes) are accepted during registration. Your team must arrive in the same composition as listed and approved in the system with the accommodation coordinator.
- If you have not sent scanned **signed** liability waivers, consents for personal data processing, and safety declarations for your entire team (including accompanying persons), these **documents must be provided** at registration. Without these, participation in the Games is not possible!

TRANSPORT

EMIL OPEN – ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Transportation to the Games is individual. If you arrive by car, private bus, or minibus, parking is available directly at Hotel Clarion.

Transportation from the bus/train station or airport to Hotel Clarion and back was arranged individually with the transportation coordinator. If agreed upon, transport to the hotel will be waiting for you.

TRANSPORT DURING GAMES

A bus will transport participants to the Ski Resort Lipno. If you arrive by minibus, bus, or want to use your own car, it is possible.

Use of organized transport between Hotel Clarion and Ski Resort Lipno must have been reported to the transportation coordinator – if not, individual transportation is assumed.

ACCOMMODATION

At Hotel Clarion, you will find an information desk marked with the Emil Open logo upon entering the building. Coordinators will be present on Tuesday, January 21, and Wednesday, January 22, 2025, to assist with various situations and provide necessary information about the competitions, transportation, and accompanying program.

These coordinators will register you for the Games upon arrival, issue accreditation cards, and help with accommodation registration. A storage room for sports equipment is provided.

- Presence of a pet (dog/cat) possible for a fee at the hotel to be paid by the participant, to be reported in advance. The fee for the presence of an assistance/guide dog is covered by the organizer.

BOARD

- Half board is provided by the organizer during the entire duration of the games. A packed lunch is provided for you only on the days you play sports and you will receive it directly at the sports venues;
- breakfast and dinner are provided at the hotel where you are staying, in the Veduta restaurant on the 1st floor;
- you start with dinner on the day of your arrival and end with breakfast on the day of your departure;
- there is always one portion per participant;
- the participant must be identified with an accreditation card when the meal is served;

SUMMARY / KEY INFORMATION

- Each participant will be assigned an accreditation card during Games registration, conducted at the hotel upon arrival. Keep the accreditation card with you at all times during the Games and use it for identification at the hotel, sports venues, and meal distribution. It will also be used during the accompanying program.
- If you have not sent scanned and signed liability waivers, consents for personal data processing, and safety declarations for your entire team (including accompanying persons), these documents must be provided at registration.
- Each delegation must send a representative to the technical meeting on 22 January at 20:00 to take over all the necessary information. If you are the only staff of an athlete, the athlete(s) may accompany you.
- SKI PASSES will be issued after the technical meeting deposit is 100 kč or 5€
 - We ask participants to have the exact amount of money ready
 - Ski passes will be returned on Friday at the hotel from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. on the 1st floor next to the breakfast entrance
- Breakfast and dinner are served at the Clarion Hotel, the place of accommodation, see accommodation.
- Lunch packages are issued only at the sports venue (Ski Resort Lipno).
- For the safe conduct of the games, the following must be observed::
 - the rules of this manual,
 - the traffic regulations of the Czech Republic,
 - the rules of conduct at sports grounds and other venues.
- Liability the organizer is not liable for injuries to athletes, their escorts or for accidents, illnesses, loss of objects and damage to them. Each delegation shall email a signed "declaration of liability" to the organiser by the check in date and, in the event of non-compliance, shall hand it in at Games registration. Without it, participation in the Games is not possible!
- A medical officer will be available at each venue during the Games.
- **Insurance** is taken out by each delegation separately.
- It is no longer possible to send substitutes for the athletes!
- **On Thursday at 6 pm, there will be a lecture for participants** on the topic SAFE START: prevention of risky behaviour for young people





GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Official Languages Czech, English
- Target Group Youth with disabilities (physical, visual, hearing, mental, and combined disabilities); aged from 10 to 26 years (competitors must reach the age within this year 2025 by at least one day or receive an exception).
- 3. Sports Section 1: Alpine skiing, snowboarding, Section 2: Cross-country skiing, snowshoe running, Section 3: Camps (para ice hockey, figure skating)
- 4. Categories of Competitive Sports:

OPEN

- Supports and motivates beginners
- Open category for all individuals from the target group beginners and slightly advanced, regardless of whether they are registered in sports clubs, without the condition of registration in national or international federations
- By submitting the application, it is confirmed that the registered competitor is:
 - Medically fit for sporting activity in the given sport
 - Has training experience and skills in the given sport that allow participation in competitions (in alpine skiing, cross-country skiing, snowboarding, or snowshoe running)
- Evaluation (alpine skiing, cross-country skiing, snowboarding, snowshoes): The principle of relativity will be used, which is based on evaluating current performances in relation to the individual, allowing advancement to appropriate final groups for all competitors according to the published rules. All competitors advance to the finals. The principle of forming appropriate final groups will be specified at the technical meeting of the given sport before the competitions, on Wednesday at 20:00.
- **Awards**: In the medal ceremony, all participants of the finals will be announced and awarded, with the first three places being awarded medals.

MIXED

- A format where an athlete and a non-disabled individual (coach, parent, volunteer, etc.) compete together as one pair or team
- Supports inclusion of people with disabilities
- The condition for participation is enrollment in the OPEN format in the given sport
- In the registration system, it is necessary to indicate whether the athlete will compete with their own non-disabled companion or accepts a sports partner from the ranks of the organizer's volunteers
- Awards: In the medal ceremony, all participants will be awarded a participation medal





- Further explanation in the propositions of the given sport or at the technical meeting before the competitions.
- 5. Each competitor can register for only one competitive sport.
- **6. Demonstration sports**, if any, each athlete participates based on their own decision and time possibilities.
- 7. Athletes and their companions are obliged to familiarize themselves with the rules of the sports and adhere to them, including adhering to the time schedule and designated times for entering the sports venues.
- 8. Transportation from the accommodation to the sports venues will be provided by the organizer based on demand. Any published transportation schedule must be followed. In case of own transportation, free parking will be provided.
- 9. Each sport will have an essential technical meeting for coaches and companions on Wednesday 22. January at 20:00, where leaders/trainers of delegations of the given sport will receive all necessary instructions. Another meeting will take place according to the agreement with the sport directors.
- **10.** For organizational and safety reasons, only athletes and their authorized companions have access to all sports venues, including assistance dogs.
- **11.** Athletes are required to compete with their own sports equipment (adjusted and maintained alpine and cross-country skis/monoskis, snowboards, etc.) or compensatory aids and protective equipment (helmet, goggles, gloves) suitable for safe competition. A declaration of honor and other signature documents are part of the registration process and must be submitted before departure to the games.
- **12.** The time schedule of individual competitions will be announced.
- **13.** The term PARA expresses the derivation of the word parallel for all participants, not paraplegic disability.



Evaluation: OPEN category - see General Information

On Thursday the competitor will ride two training runs, then two timed runs to qualify for the final group. These will be divided on a relative basis from 3 to 6 athletes. Friday will be the final runs of the final groups, with the faster of the two timed times determining the order within the group.

Rules: Competing according to FIS rules with specified supplements for the OPEN format and the principle of relativity and adjustments determined for sport for the disabled.

Notice for Coaches/Companions: Athlete presentation will be every morning at the sports venue. Coaches are responsible for the timely arrival of the athlete (after warm-up) for presentation and in the call room (located at the bottom station of the chairlift) according to the start time. Registration will take place before the start of the race; more information





at the technical meeting. Coaches must stay only in designated areas; further details at the initial technical meeting.

Competitors must demonstrate properly adjusted skis, etc., otherwise, they will not be allowed on the slope. Submission of a declaration of honor by the coach/companion at the initial technical meeting (part of the registration process).

The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the propositions and rules of alpine skiing if required to maintain fair play and snow conditions.

MIXED category: A pair consisting of 1 athlete from the OPEN category + 1 non-disabled companion or volunteer from the organizers competes (the athlete creates the pair in the registration system with their partner/companion; if not, the organizer will pair the athlete with a volunteer). Club or nationality affiliation does not need to be maintained





Evaluation: OPEN category – according to the principle of relativity. All advance to the finals formed based on current performances achieved with maximum effort in qualification. The relay is directly the final.

Rules: Competing according to valid rules. Start signal by whistle, tactile signal, or touch by the starter. Depending on snow conditions, starts will be interval-based at 15-30 sec, individually. Relay with mass start.

Notice for Coaches/Companions: Athlete presentation will be every morning at the sports venue. Coaches are responsible for the timely arrival of the athlete (after warm-up) for presentation and in the call room according to the start time. Registration at the start no earlier than 15 minutes and no later than 10 minutes before the actual start time. Coaches must stay only in designated areas; further details at the initial technical meeting.

Competitors must demonstrate properly prepared equipment; otherwise, they will not be allowed to start. Anti-slip, so-called climbing skins are not allowed.

The organizer reserves the right to change or modify the propositions and rules of crosscountry skiing if required to maintain fair play and the snow or hygienic conditions of the situation.

- Relay 3x 1 Circuit (club or nationality affiliation does not need to be maintained)

The competition system will depend on snow conditions. A competitor in the OPEN category can register for one of the listed disciplines plus the relay 3x1 Circuit. Qualification





competitions will take place on 23 January from 10:00 to 14:00. Finals on 24 January from 10:00 to 14:00.

MIXED Discipline: A pair consisting of 1 athlete from the OPEN category + 1 non-disabled companion or volunteer from the organizers competes (the athlete creates the pair in the registration system with their partner/companion; if not, the organizer will pair the athlete with a volunteer). Club or nationality affiliation does not need to be maintained.

Evaluation: OPEN category – according to the principle of relativity. All advance to the finals formed based on current performances achieved with maximum effort in qualification. Relays are only finals.

Rules: Competing according to valid rules. Start signal by whistle, tactile signal, or touch by the starter. Depending on snow conditions, starts will be interval-based at 15-30 sec, individually.

Notice for Coaches/Companions: Athlete presentation will be every morning at the sports venue. Coaches are responsible for the timely arrival of the athlete (after warm-up) for presentation and in the call room according to the start time. Registration at the start no earlier than 15 minutes and no later than 10 minutes before the actual start time. Coaches must stay only in designated areas; further details at the initial technical meeting on Wednesday 22.01. at 20:00.
